MARCUS EATON WILL HEADLINE JULY 27TH CONCERT

The Teton Valley Foundation is pleased to announce Marcus Eaton will headline the Thursday Music on Main July 27th show. Thursday Music on Main, a weekly concert series in Downtown Driggs, is free to the public and features prominent headliners performing from 6-9 pm every Thursday in July and August.

Eaton mixes soulful pop-rock melodies, R&B-inflicted vocals, guitar-driven rhythms and life affirming lyrics. In addition to supporting Tim Reynolds in '06, a good musical match due to Marcus' Dave Mathewesque sound, Eaton has spent his career playing the best venues all across the West. Playing with Jewel, John Mayer, and Jason Mraz and a new album coming out this fall, there is a lot in the future for this musician.

Concerts will take place in the new Main Street Park in downtown Driggs at the corner of Bates and Main. Concertgoers are encouraged to bring their own chairs and blankets. Families are encouraged to attend but, regrettably, we ask that you leave your dogs at home. Vendors will be on site to provide food and drinks. Concerts will be held outdoors, rain or shine, provided the weather is safe for the musicians and equipment.
