MELVIN SEALS & JGB WITH SPECIAL GUEST STEVE KIMOCK ROUND OUT MUSIC ON MAIN SERIES

The Teton Valley Foundation is pleased to announce that Melvin Seals & JGB with special guest Steve Kimock will headline the Thursday Music on Main closing show on August 28. Thursday Music on Main, a weekly concert series in Downtown Driggs, is free to the public and features prominent headliners performing each week. Shows are from 6:00-9:30 p.m. every Thursday in July and August, beginning July 10. Our closing show will begin at 5:30 p.m. with the Miller Sisters, followed by The Hooligans, topped off with our headliner.

Melvin Seals, a powerful presence in the music industry for over 30 years, is best known for his long friendship and musical partnership with cultural icon and guitarist Jerry Garcia. Melvin served as Jerry's keyboardist from 1980 onward and helped pioneer what has now become known as "jam band music." From blues to funk to rock to jazz, Melvin Seals serves up a tasty mix with a little R&B and gospel thrown in to spice things up.

Kimock, our special guest, is one of today's most talented guitarists and composers – a master musician known for his uncanny ability to balance passion and power with soaring grace. Relix magazine recently dubbed him "The Guitar Monk" for his relentless pursuit of 'Zen and the art of guitar.' Come see a musical legend in downtown Driggs!
