TETON VALLEY FOUNDATION ANNOUNCES LOS LOBOS AND JERRY JOSEPH WILL HEADLINE THURSDAY MUSIC ON MAIN

The Teton Valley Foundation is pleased to announce Los Lobos will headline the July 26th Thursday Music on Main show. Thursday Music on Main, a weekly concert series in Downtown Driggs, is free to the public and features prominent headliners performing each week. Shows are from 6-9:30 pm every Thursday in July and August

Hailing from East L.A., Los Lobos has been entertaining audiences for over 30 years with its diverse repertoire. Drawing on blues, rockabilly, jazz, Latin and their Mexican-American heritage, this band appeals to a wide variety of musical tastes and promises to be a show to remember.

Jerry Joseph will return to the Tetons on August 30th for an encore performance, this time with his electric band, to provide plenty of trademark rhythmic spirit and honest grit.

The Foundation expects to announce the local artists opening each show in the coming week.
